53 of the total population. He is applying for a grant and would like to get \$10,000 from Sanpete County
54 and Sevier County. He is asking the cities/towns in each county to pay \$1.00 citizen living in their city
55 or town. The match he needs is about \$77,000 total. He is still working on the grant and will not know
56 for awhile if he got the money or not. After it is finalized then he will have a better idea of what he
57 needs in matching funds.
