9. Ryan Jolley - Update on Water Project

There is a lot going on in town with this water project. The well is at 313 feet. Water is between 100 and 200 feet and at the 300 foot depth. They should be able to case it soon and get the flow tests completed.

The tank is progressing fast. They should be about ready to pour the lid. They are expecting a November completion date.

The pipe is going good. They are almost ready to tie into the tank then move to other tasks.

The asphalt was a concern because of the plants shutting down for the winter. They believe this issue is resolved. They have arranged to get the major crossings done ASAP.

They are under budget on the spring project and expect to be under on the well also. Any extra money will be used on needed water-related projects.

10. Resolution 2010-14 A resolution setting reservation rules for the use of pavilions a the Mt. Pleasant City Park and for Camping Sites at the City Power Plant Park.

City Treasurer, Dave Oxman, requested this resolution. He felt it would protect the city.
