REGULAR MEETING

The Mt. Pleasant City Council held a regular meeting November 22, 2011 at 7:30 p.m. The meeting was held in the Council Chambers, 115 West Main, Mt. Pleasant, Utah.

1. Welcome
Mayor welcomed everyone to the meeting.
2. Opening Ceremony/Pledge of Allegiance
Mayor led the council in the pledge of allegiance.
3. Roll Call

4. Approval of Agenda Items
Motion to approve the agenda excluding item 8 regarding Wasatch: Coleen.

6. Approval of Claims & Requisitions:
