



39 **9. Moratorium on Irrigation Connections**

40 This was an item the Mayor wanted to discuss but she was unable to attend the meeting. The council  
41 discussed the concerns and asked for input from the citizens in the audience. A gentleman who said he  
42 was over the water in Moroni was present and he told the group that Moroni drilled a well and the  
43 water was not able to be put into the culinary supply so it is used to supply water in the irrigation  
44 system. They have to pump the water but they have not run out of water this year.  
45 Monte read part of an email that was received from the City Attorney Richard Chamberlain, he said  
46 there was no restrictions on the City regarding moratoriums. There is nothing the citizens can do legally  
47 if we cut off the ability to connect to irrigation. He suggested that we require citizens to bring a share  
48 of water if they wish to connect to pressurized irrigation. Thelma & Linda thought they were told that  
49 even if they bought a share of water they could not connect to pressurized irrigation. Justin Atkinson  
50 said they may have misunderstood they can't connect if there isn't a main line to supply them with  
51 service. Council agreed that it needs a lot more study to determine what will be done with the water.

53 **10. Mayor's Report**

54 The Mayor had left some things for Monte to give council. There will be two separate trainings in  
55 Ephraim in October for Land Use.

56 There was also an email from Ron Dimik, who has repeatedly complained about dust on the road to the  
57 arena. Reed said that the dust is not coming from people going to the arena. There are a number of  
58 homes down that road and they come into town several times a day. The road is also used by farmers  
59 going to their fields. The road runs into a county road he wondered if the county would help pave the  
60 road.

61 Mr. Dimik wanted to know where the road is on the priority list. The Council agreed it is way down the  
62 list. We can't afford to pave the streets in town we are not going to start on the streets running out of  
63 town down a dirt road. Mr. Dimik doesn't live here full time and he should have been aware of the  
64 issue before he purchased a home for part time living.
