Monte met with the Main Street Committee earlier in the day. The focus of the meeting was ways they could clean up the town, and especially Main Street. They are trying to find grants to clean up and mend the sidewalks on Main Street.

Monte commented the library is an anchor of the main street economic development effort. The carpeting is down in the library, and they are close to being able to move back in.

**7. Chairman's Report**

Mayor reported Monte will ask the Main Street Committee if they would be willing to serve as a city beautification committee. Jim Wilberg, the police chief agreed he will do what he can to enforce zoning ordinances.

Justin suggested putting an ad in the paper advising of some of the zoning ordinances, which are commonly violated, and the potential consequence of violating them. The Mayor agreed this was a good idea.
