## Mt. Pleasant City Resolution 2010-01

## A RESOLUTION SETTING CULINARY WATER RATES FOR THE CITIZENS OF MT. PLEASANT.

WHEREAS, The Mayor and City Council recognize that a municipality must continue to maintain and improve its culinary water system, and

WHEREAS, the current culinary system needs to be upgraded in order to provide for service to the current and future residents of Mt. Pleasant, and

**WHEREAS**, the City was able to obtain a loan from the Community Impact Board (CIB) based on the stipulation that we increase water rates in order to retire the debt on the loan.

## NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE CULINARY WATER RATES FOR MT. PLEASANT CITY WILL BE AS FOLLOWS:

\$22.00 for the first 3,000 gallons of water

\$1.50 for the overage of 3,001 to 20,000 gallons

\$2.00 for the overage of 20,001 to 50,000

\$2.50 of any overage over 50,001

The new rate schedule will become effective February 1, 2010.
