It's License Month!!

Business Licenses and Dog Licenses are due for renewal January 2019.



Dog License's

All animal licenses expire on December 31st of the applicable year of the license, and a new license must be obtained prior to January 31st of the new year. Animals are as follows:

Neutered males and spayed females \$12.00.

Males and females not spayed or neutered \$17.00.

Proof of rabies shots and wormer will also need to be provided at time of license. Licenses were previously distributed by the local vet. This has been changed, **you can pay and pick up licenses at the City Hall.**

If you have a dog picked up by animal control that is not licensed you will have to pay for your dog to be licensed or a citation may be issued.

Business License's

You should have received information to renew your business license. Please read them carefully and return the correct amount due. Amounts do change based on the number of employees and the type of business.

All license fees **not paid by 1st of February** of each year shall be increased by **5%** of the total license fee due. License fees **not paid by the 1st of March** of each year shall be increased by **10%**. License fees **not paid by the first of June** of each year shall be increased by **50%** of the total license due.

When a business fails to apply and pay for a business license by the first of June, the city recorder shall send a letter to the owner of the business asking him to comply with this article within (5) days from the date shown on the letter. In the event the owner/operator fails to comply, the city recorder shall refer the matter to the chief of police and the city attorney.
