

**Mt. Pleasant City
Minutes
Public Hearing Tentative Budget 2018/2019
June 7, 2018**

Mt. Pleasant City held a public hearing on June 7, 2018, at 6:30 p.m. The location of the public hearing was the Mt. Pleasant City Council Chambers, 115 West Main, Mt. Pleasant, Utah. The purpose of the meeting was to receive input from the public with respect to the Tentative Budget for 2018/2019. All members of the public were invited to attend and participate.

Council Member Kevin Stallings opened the public hearing and explained what the purpose of the public hearing is. He also read the notice regarding the public hearings. Dan Anderson motioned to accept the outline for the public hearings as outlined. 2nd: Heidi Kelso.

It was requested to have the mayor's budget letter read into record. Councilman Stallings read the letter. The councilmembers in attendance looked over the budget and had a small discussion on the budget. There were a few questions about amount employees are getting paid and how we need to somehow get our pay scale up, so it is comparable to other towns in the area. Our Power Department Superintendent express his concern about losing great employees because we can't compete with other cities pay scales. It was suggested to make this a structural change, not cost of living.
