He's helped to build many communities and feels it's time to work on his own community. He stated he has a younger perspective on things. He also had a written statement prepared for Council. Each council member shared some thoughts with the candidates. They then voted by paper ballot. Russell Keisel won receiving 3 votes. Matt Anderson received 1 vote and McKade Lusk received 0 votes.
