5. Mayor's Report

Asked Colter to report on irrigation:

--Twin Creek is up

--West Zone are up and running

--Central Zone was started, but butterfly valve problems. Have ordered a new one and hopefully will have it up and running by end of week. The main trunk line must be drained. It will affect everyone on Pleasant Creek, including the farmers.

Shane reported to mayor on cost to put power out to Phase V in industrial park. Have approximately 9 acres sold. Need vellum signed so it can be recorded at the county. \$83,000 to get power to all those lots. Sewer to these lots is not available to first 5 lots until Phase IV is done. Must wait for grant and contract those out. Water is there to hook into. Need to sell lots before they can put the infrastructure in. We have 18 lots, and approximately 7 lots are spoken for. Soon as lots are paid for, city can start putting infrastructure in.

Parks are being cleaned and prepared to open. City has started to mow city lawns. Have placed some poles and made it so people can't pull into the park. The sprinkling system must be moved from where it was on the train depot side, to the city property. They will be spraying for weeds this week in the flower boxes at the cemetery, and at both ends of town.

Memorial Day is coming up and we are starting to prepare for that.
