A RESOLUTION AMENDING RESOLUTION 2022-15 A RESOLUTION
ESTABLISHING ELECTRIC POWER RATES

WHEREAS, Mt. Pleasant City maintains an electric power system; and

WHEREAS, Mt. Pleasant City Municipal Code 8-5-6 allows the City Council to establish electric power rates; and

WHEREAS, the price of energy purchased by Mt. Pleasant City that it then provides to its customers has increased significantly; and

WHEREAS, in order to protect the health, safety, and welfare of the residents of the City and the power customers it serves, it is important to establish appropriate rates to pay for the services provided; and

WHEREAS, Mt. Pleasant City Contracted with Utility Financial Solutions to perform a rate study for the purpose of completing our capital facilities plan; and

WHEREAS, Utility Financial Solutions advises raising power rates this year by approximately 6.5% per year to accomplish capital facilities plan and keep up with rising energy costs.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by Mt. Pleasant City Council the electrical rates for the customers of Mt. Pleasant power will increase as follows:

1. **Rate Schedule 101**, Residential Rate within the City limits,
 - a. Base charge of \$21.00 per month
 - b. the \$/kWh charged for the energy used each monthly billing cycle will be:
 - i. \$.091 (0-500 kWh)
 - ii. \$.11250 (501 - 1,500 kWh)
 - iii. \$.11250 (Excess)

2. **Rate Schedule 102**, Residential Rate outside of the City limits,
 - a. Base charge of \$21.00 per month
 - b. The \$/kWh charged for the energy used each monthly billing cycle will be:
 - i. \$.091 (0-500 kWh)
 - ii. \$.11250 (501 - 1,500 kWh)
 - iii. \$.11250 (Excess)

3. **Rate Schedule 104**, Commercial No Demand Rate within the City limits,
 - a. Base charge of \$28.25 per month
 - b. The \$/kWh charged for the energy used each monthly billing cycle will be:
 - i. \$.091 (0-1,000 kWh)
 - ii. \$.11250 (1,001 - 1,500 kWh)
 - iii. \$.11250 (Excess)

4. **Rate Schedule 105**, Commercial No Demand Rate outside of the City limits,
 - a. Base charge of \$28.25 per month

- b. The \$/kWh charged for the energy used each monthly billing cycle will be:
 - i. \$.091 (0-1,000 kWh)
 - ii. \$.11250 (1,001 - 1,500 kWh)
 - iii. \$.11250 (Excess)

- 5. **Rate Schedule 106, Commercial With Demand Rate within the City limits,**
 - a. Base charge of 31.00 per month
 - b. Demand charge of \$11.00 per kW of peak demand during the monthly billing cycle.
 - c. The \$/kWh charged for the energy used each monthly billing cycle will be:
 - i. \$.087 (0-5,000 kWh)
 - ii. \$.080 (5,001 – 10,000 kWh)
 - iii. \$.06150 (Excess)

- 6. **Rate Schedule 107, Commercial With Demand Rate outside of the City limits,**
 - a. Base charge of \$31.00 per month
 - b. Demand charge of \$11.00 per kW of peak demand during monthly billing cycle.
 - c. The \$/kWh charged for the energy used each monthly billing cycle will be:
 - i. \$.087 (0-5,000 kWh)
 - ii. \$.080 (5,001 – 10,000 kWh)
 - iii. \$.06150 (Excess)

- 7. **Rate Schedule 109, Temp. Fee Rate within City limits,**
 - a. Base charge of \$33.00 per month
 - b. The \$/kWh charged for the energy used each monthly billing cycle will be:
 - i. \$.091 (0-500 kWh)
 - ii. \$.11250 (501 – 1,500 kWh)
 - iii. \$.11250(excess)

- 8. **Rate Schedule 110, Temp Fee Rate outside of the City limits,**
 - a. Base charge of \$33.00 per month
 - b. The \$/kWh charged for the energy used each monthly billing cycle will be:
 - i. \$.091 (0-500 kWh)
 - ii. \$.11250 (501 – 1,500 kWh)
 - iii. \$.11250(excess)

- 9. **Rate Schedule 125, Agriculture Rate,**
 - a. No monthly base charge will be assessed.
 - b. On Peak \$/kWh \$ 0.10700
Off Peak \$/kWh \$ 0.05350

Demand Charge:

 - On Peak Demand \$ 10.00
 - Off Peak Demand \$ 5.00

- 10. **Rate Schedule public lighting**

Monthly Facilities Charge:	
100 Watt HPS	\$11.00
71 Watt LED	\$11.00
160 Watt Road Focus LED	\$11.00

11. These rates shall supersede Resolution 2022-15 and become effective on the 1st day of April, 2023, or the first day of the billing cycle of such later month as practical to accommodate the City's billing cycle.
