### **AGE CATEGORIES**

Tiny Tots\*: Ages 3-5 (does not compete in talent category)

Mini: 1<sup>ST</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> Grade

Little: 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> Grade

Junior: 7<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> Grade

### **JUDGING CRITERIA\***

Contestants will be judged on-stage in the following categories:

*\*Tiny Tot's will be judged on Evening/Novelty Wear (50%) and Speech/Quote/Phrase (50%)*

- **Evening/Novelty Wear: (25%)** this can be a ball gown, a costume, a church dress, anything that represents the theme and the contestant. The 2023 theme is PATRIOTIC. Contestants will model this attire on stage for the audience. The contestant will be judged on confidence; poise and overall presentation of personal style, attitude, and personality. Each contestant is competing against herself and receives a score from 1-10.
- **Talent: (25%)** Contestants will demonstrate their talent on stage in an appropriate costume that compliments the talent. The time limit is 90 seconds. There is no LIVE accompaniment. Music for dance, etc. must be provided prior to dress rehearsal in a format that the director will disclose at parent orientation meeting. The contestant is judged on their performance, showmanship, and interpretive ability (age consideration given). Each contestant is competing against herself and receives a score from 1-10. No Live props or excessive props.

- **Speech/Quote/Phrase: (50%)** The contestant will read (memorization preferred) a speech, quote, or phrase of their choice in relation to the 2023 PATRIOTIC theme for the audience/judges. It is not to exceed 60 seconds. Contestants can wear whatever they choose for this portion of the pageant. Contestants will be judged on charisma, interpretive ability, confidence, and tone. Each contestant is competing against herself and receives a score from 1-10.

## **ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES AGREEMENT**

- Contestant is a female residing in Sanpete County
- Contestant meets the age criteria
- Contestant/Parents agree to be kind and courteous examples as an ambassador/representative of Mt. Pleasant City
- Selected Royalty agrees to Wear sash/crown at all appearances
- Selected Royalty/Parents agree to be on time to all appearances
- Contestant/Selected Royalty agrees to be neat, clean kempt and presentable at all appearances
- Contestant/Parents understand that the judges' decisions are final
- Contestant/Parents understand that no scores will be given or distributed post pageant
- Contestant/Parents understand that the pageant director, pageant committee and/or Mt. Pleasant City is not responsible for the outcome of the pageant
- Contestant/Parents understand that the purpose of this pageant is to build community, contestant confidence, talent skill & ability, showmanship, and leadership skills
- Contestant/Parents understand that there will be no private interview segment of the pageant – all areas of competition are open to the public
- Contestant/Parent understands that (1) female may assist contestant backstage during the pageant for support with wardrobe, getting to/from stage call, etc.
- Selected Royalty/Parents Agree to Attend the following Mt. Pleasant City Events:
  - June 30, 2023 – Family Fun Night – Mt. Pleasant Rodeo Grounds, time and what to wear to be announced – you will be introduced inside the rodeo arena
  - July 1, 2023 – Hub City Rodeo – Mt. Pleasant Rodeo Grounds, time and what to wear to be announced – you will be introduced inside the rodeo arena
  - July 3, 2023 – Hub City Rodeo – Mt. Pleasant Rodeo Grounds, time and what to wear to be announced – you will be introduced inside the rodeo arena
  - July 4, 2023 – 11:30am – PARADE – A float will be provided, instructions on what to wear and where to meet will be announced
  - July 4, 2023 – 1:00pm-4:00pm – Mt. Pleasant City Park Entertainment, Vendor Booths, etc. You will be helping the Miss Mt. Pleasant Royalty with Prizes, and more. Pie Eating Contest: 2:30pm – you will be helping with prizes.

- July 4, 2023 – Hub City Rodeo – Mt. Pleasant Rodeo Grounds, time and what to wear to be announced – you will be introduced inside the rodeo arena
- November/December, 2023– Mt. Pleasant City Mainstreet Christmas Lighting – time and date to be announced
